## **GVTP Tree Sponsorship Conditions**

1. Sponsorship of trees at GVTP is welcomed.
2. The cost of such sponsorship is normally \$120 (This figure may be revised from time to time). Special trees may be offered at a premium price.
3. The sponsors name (only) shall be engraved on an aluminum tag which shall be placed together with and below that tree's identification plate on the mounting post or block.
4. Choice of tree shall only be from the current "Trees Available for Sponsorship List" provided by the GVTP Tree sub-committee comprising of established trees that show good prospects for longer term survival.
5. Sponsorship is for the life of the tree.
6. Where the sponsored tree dies or is for any reason removed within 30 years from the date of sponsorship a replacement tree will be provided with the sponsor being invited to choose the replacement from the "Trees Available for Sponsorship List" current at the time.
7. Where the sponsored tree dies or is for any reason removed more than 30 years from the date of sponsorship its plaque will be placed on a dedicated long-term sponsorship board.
8. Sponsorship of the one tree by more than one person is acceptable where all existing sponsors show their agreement, or where such agreement might be reasonably inferred in the case of deceased family members. In such cases 50% discount shall apply to the subsequent sponsorships.
9. GVTP is not intended to be a memorial park; sponsors need be aware that whilst the placement of ashes of the deceased is not prohibited the GTVP Committee reserves the right to remove any tree for any reason. Attempt will be made to provide reasonable advance notice of removal to the sponsor in such cases.
10. The Committee may at its discretion make special agreements regarding tree sponsorship where these would be of greater benefit to the Park than is normally the case.
11. Sponsors should be aware of the above conditions.
12. Sponsors should note that although arrangements are made in good faith, the management of the Committee will change from time to time, and future committees may change the present guidelines and policies to reflect conditions at that time. Sponsorship can only be offered on this basis.
